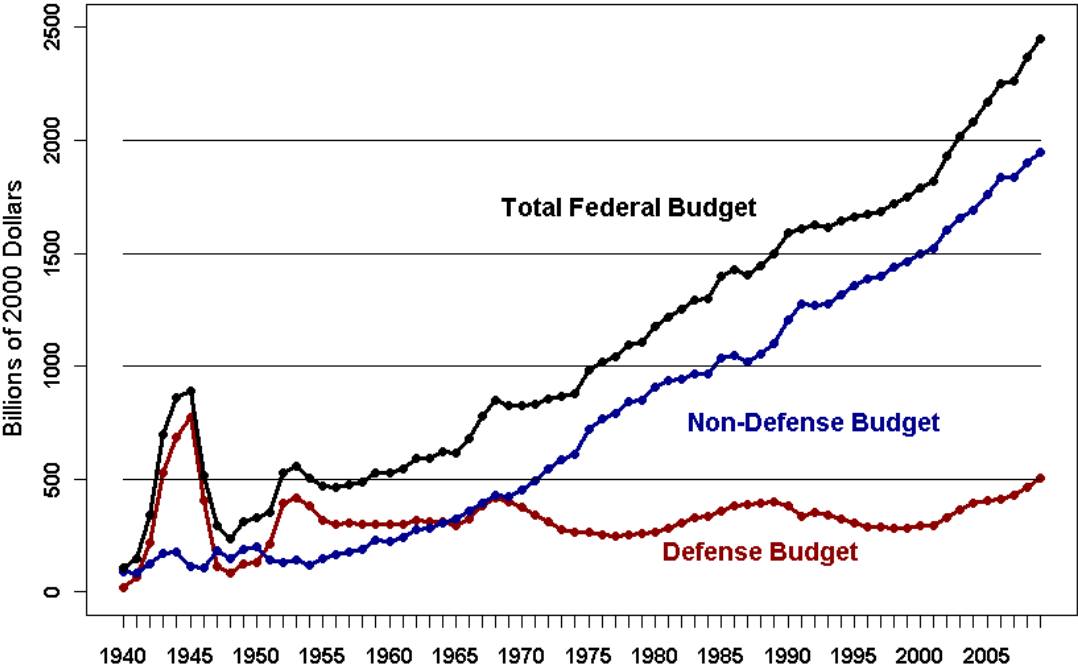
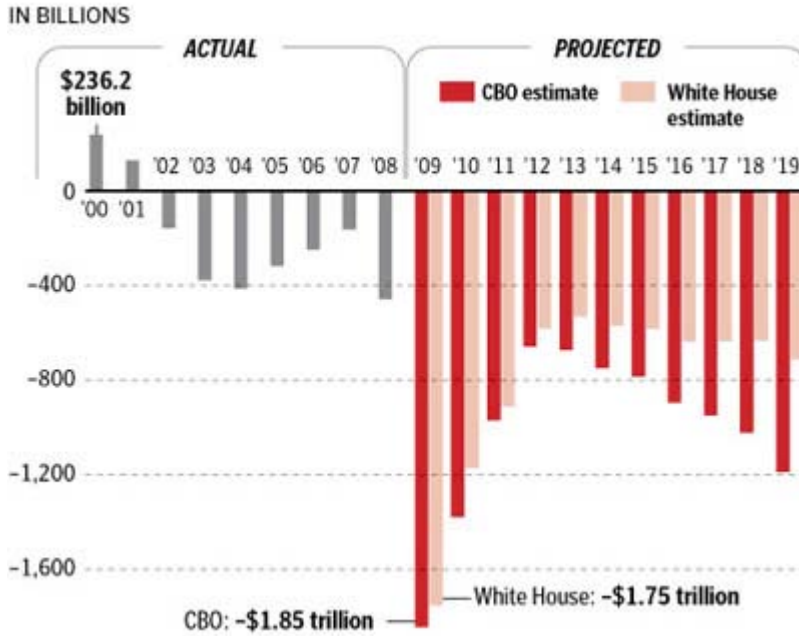
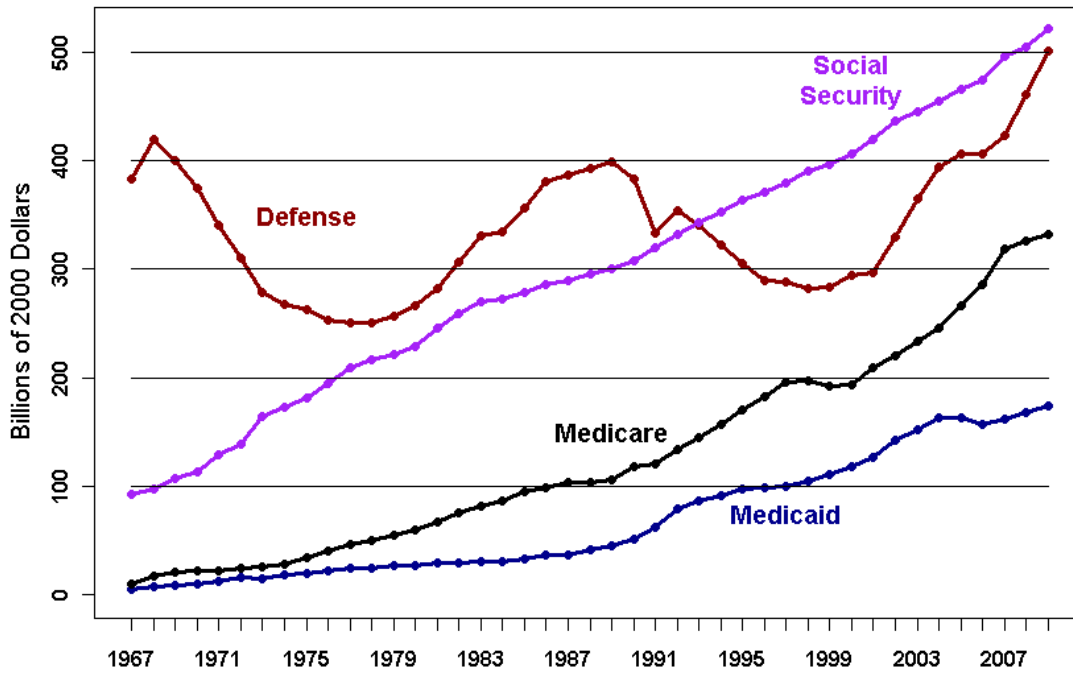

(2000 Dollars) 1940 - 2009

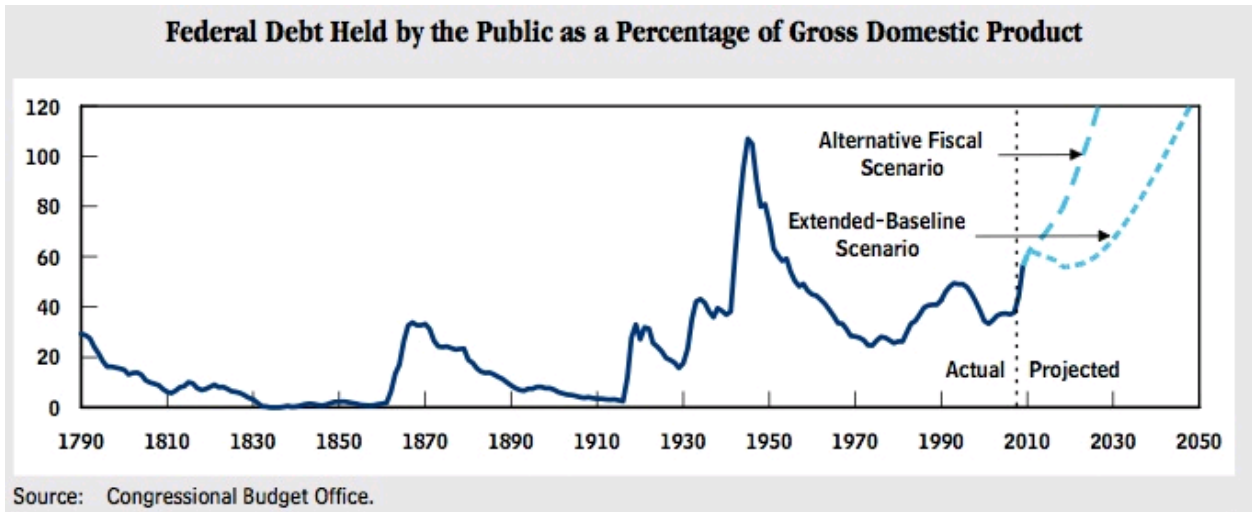




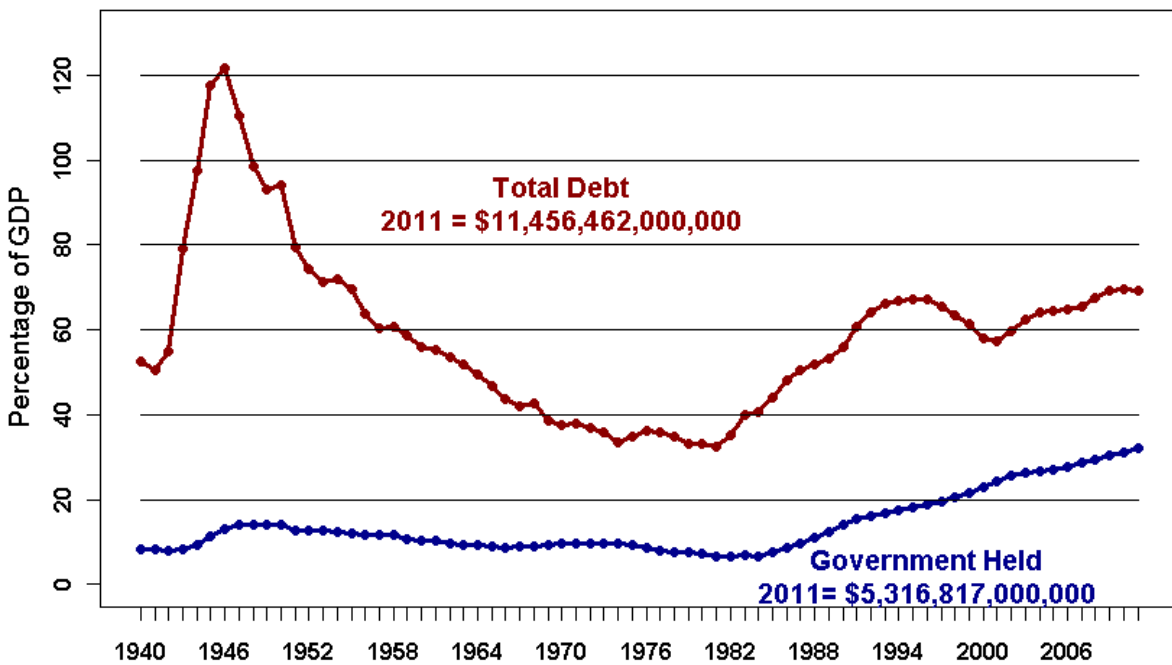
**Federal Budget: Defense, Medicaid, Medicare, and Social Security (2000 Dollars) 1967 - 2009**
